

Lake Taupō Navigation Safety Amendment Bylaw 2020

Pursuant to sections 33M and 33W(4) of the Maritime Transport Act 1994, the Minister of Local Government makes the following bylaw.

1 Title

This bylaw is the Lake Taupō Navigation Safety Amendment Bylaw 2020.

2 Commencement

This bylaw comes into force 28 days after it is signed.

3 Principal Bylaw amended

This bylaw amends the Lake Taupō Navigation Safety Bylaw 2017 (the **principal Bylaw**).

4 Clause 2.15 amended

Clause 2.15 is deleted and replaced by the following:

“2.15 Registration of personal watercraft (jet ski)

2.15.1 Every personal watercraft used in or on the waters of the Lake must be registered with a regional council.

2.15.2 The owner of a personal watercraft being used on the Lake must ensure that the personal watercraft’s registration number is:

- (a) displayed on both sides of the personal watercraft above the waterline;
and
- (b) clearly legible; and
- (c) displayed using characters at least 90 mm in height.”

5 Schedule 1 of the principal Bylaw amended

Schedule 1 of the principal Bylaw is amended by deleting the item “Waihaha Bay”.

6 Schedule 2 of the principal Bylaw amended

Schedule 2 of the principal Bylaw is amended by inserting the following item after paragraph (f):

- “(g) **Pukawa** - the area starting 10 metres south of the Pukawa Stream, extending for 140 metres north, bounded by parallel lines extending from either end of this area to a distance of approximately 150 metres from the lake margin at normal lake level in a direction of 080° (true).”
