

## Lake Taupō Navigation Safety Amendment Bylaw 2019

Pursuant to sections 33M and 33R(1)(d) of the Maritime Transport Act 1994, the Minister of Local Government makes the following bylaw.

### 1. Title

This bylaw is the Lake Taupō Navigation Safety Amendment Bylaw 2019.

### 2. Commencement

This bylaw comes into force on 1 November 2019.

### 3. Principal bylaw amended

This bylaw amends the Lake Taupō Navigation Safety Bylaw 2017.

### 4. Definitions

Clause 1.3 is amended by inserting the definition of **mooring permit** in alphabetical order:  
“**mooring permit** means a permit issued under bylaw 9”

### 5. New part 9 inserted

The following part is inserted after part 8:

#### **PART 9 – Mooring Permits**

##### *Mooring permits*

#### **9.1 Requirement for mooring permit**

(1) No person may place or maintain a mooring in the lake except under the authority of a mooring permit and in accordance with any conditions of the permit.

(2) The harbourmaster may,—

(a) on application, issue a mooring permit set out in Schedule 3; and

(b) include in the mooring permit any conditions of mooring that are reasonably necessary to protect the mooring or to ensure maritime safety.

#### **9.2 Transfer or modification of mooring permit**

(1) A mooring permit may not be transferred, assigned, or hired under any rule of law or equity.

(2) A purported transfer, assignment, or hiring of a mooring permit is void.
